The CareersXpo is an annual event which is organised by the Rotary Club of Canberra City with support from the ACT Education Directorate. It has been operating for over 30 years and has grown in popularity each year. In 2016, the CareersXpo attracted almost 8000 visitors from Canberra and regional NSW.

As part of the 2017 CareersXpo, we are again setting up a *Try'aSkill* exhibition. *Try'aSkill* is a hands on and interactive display where students can try their hand at various skill and trade areas such as laying a brick, planting a seedling, applying makeup to a model or mixing a mocktail!



Exhibitors in 2016 included Robogals, Engineers without Borders, Surveying and Spatial Sciences Institute, Australian Culinary Federation, Cummins South Pacific, St John Ambulance, Canberra Institute of Technology, and Territory & Municipal Services.

The cost of a *Try'aSkill* stall is free and exhibitors are provided with power, tables and chairs. *Try'aSkill* exhibitors find the experience to be highly valuable in promoting their skill or trade area and educating young people about their industry.
